The forest and the mangabey are being threatened by a range of human activities including bauxite mining, illegal logging and hunting. The need for action is urgent. Your gift today will help us to protect the mangabey and the biodiversity of the Atewa Forest.

Bio-sand water filter, Uganda

Over 9 million men, women and children in Uganda do not have access to clean, safe drinking water. Children die every day from preventable diseases caused by contaminated water and improper sanitation and hygiene. You can help provide the gift of clean water today by purchasing a bio-sand water filter for a family in need. These filters remove up to 99% of pathogens and parasites without the need for chemical treatment or boiling, reducing water-borne diseases. The reduced charcoal use also means that families have more money to spend on other essentials and, with fewer trees needing to be cut down, habitats are protected. Ref: 67 £66

Sack gardening, Uganda

Sack gardens offer families a way to grow their own vegetables where space is limited or where flooding is frequent. Gardening provides a healthier diet, and brings people closer to nature. Your gift today will help us purchase land to protect species like the Sokoke Scops Owl and run conservation programmes to reduce the rate of woodland clearance. To commemorate your gift, you'll receive a certificate for the land purchased.

Beehives for a community, Kenya

A Rocha Kenya's beekeeping programme is working with 100 farmers across Dakatcha Woodland, equipping communities with beehives and training. Your gift will provide 10 hives and the basic skills to

increase the farmers' income and reduce their dependence

Bio-sand filter training for a church or community, Uganda

by the church or community members. Participation can offer 150 people access to clean, safe drinking water, save £4,200 in charcoal costs and medical fees and prevent 90 trees from being cut down each year.
